Dear Parents/Guardians,

SwimSafer Programme for Primary 3 in Term 1

The school is organising SwimSafer, a compulsory swimming programme for all Primary 3 students. SwimSafer is a national water safety programme introduced by the National Water Safety Council in 2010 which combines both the National Survival Swimming Award (NASSA) and the Learn-To-Swim Programme (LTSP) into a progressive six-stage programme. SwimSafer is designed to teach children the important life skill of swimming in a fun and safe way. The progressive nature of the programme will help children of all ages and abilities develop water safety and swimming skills at their own pace through a positive and fun learning experience. The swimming programme will be conducted by SwimSafer accredited swimming instructors at an improved ratio of 1 instructor to 10 students. A teacher will accompany the students throughout the course.

The details of the swimming programme are as follows:

Dates: 17 Jan, 24 Jan, 7 Feb, 14 Feb, 21 Feb and 7 Mar (For Classes 3ABCD)

Time: 2 p.m. – 5.20 p.m.

Attire: **Girls:** 1-piece swimsuit, wetsuit or 2-piece swimsuit (Tankini)

Boys: Swimming briefs/trunks or wetsuit

Venue: Sengkang Swimming Complex

Cost: Fees for lessons, entrance and test are subsidised by the school

Transport is provided to take students to the swimming pool and back to school. Please fill up and sign the attached Consent Form and return it to your child's form teacher by **Monday, 9 January**. We need 1 parent-volunteer per class per day to assist the teacher in looking after the children during the swimming lessons. If you are able to help out as a parent-volunteer for at least one session, please indicate accordingly on the consent form and the form teacher will get in touch with you.
